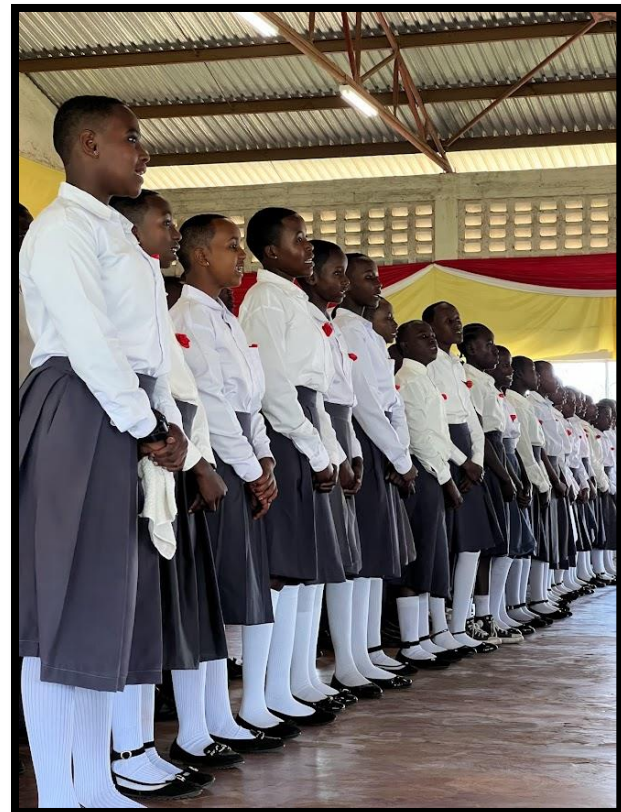

Reminder: Your students would love pictures of yourself and family, but please refrain from pictures of affluence such as cars and homes, etc. God bless you, abundantly!

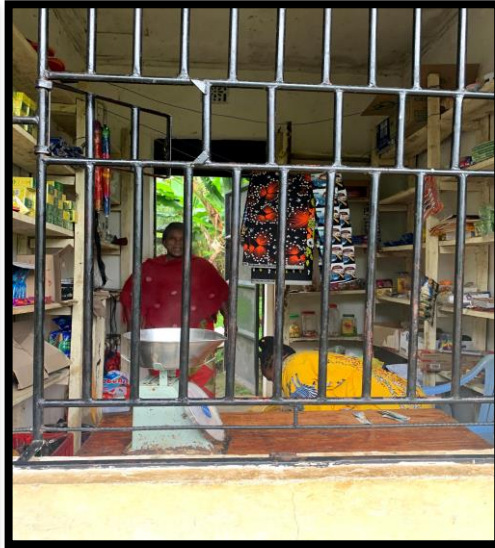


Duka Baskets for Student Families
