Martha's Helpers are making 80 quilts this year so each child in the class of 2007 will have a blanket.

M. & L. work tirelessly along side us, giving of themselves and their resources.

A.G. just lost her husband but still wants to support her little child, Godness.

J.T. and mom gave us all those toothbrushes last year. And the toothpaste came from Dr. J.

Six of you have already given support for your children clear through the seventh grade.

So many of you write little notes and send pictures and stickers to your little ones.

M.B. just sent us a large check, and, so many of you send us extra money that we were able to buy lots of beans and corn, enabling us to bless many families in the area suffering from the six-year drought.

Because of you, the school has 12 classrooms, 10 acres, two wells, electricity, and much, much more.


That's all in just less than four years.
