This is because she went into labor by herself and wouldn't allow people to help her. When people saw that she was pregnant with the last one, Joyce, they kept a close watch on her. With the help of those close to her family, Joyce was born as the only surviving child in her family. She continues to live a very difficult life because in addition to her parents being mentally challenged, they are also alcoholics. When Joyce was asked if there's anything she'd liked, she simply replied, "...I just need your prayers. I would like prayers so that my parents will one day have good mind like the other parents." Joyce is incredibly smart and she does well at school. She is at the top of her class.



"Even though she lives a difficult life at home, she's very thankful that she has this opportunity to study at Sluys/Anderson, where she gets education, food, uniforms and "equal treatment". There is no possible way that she would have attended a regular primary school if she hadn't been accepted at Sluys/Anderson. Her parents do not have enough money to buy food, let alone school supplies. They live in a 12x15 shack between the three of them. Please continue to pray for her and her family so that one day the light of Christ will shine through their home. I am moved to tears to how many lives are being transformed because of your gifts of love. Thank you. Lord bless you all."
