- School budget met every month.
- Over \$37,000 supplemental food purchased to relieve suffering due to drought.
- 13 tons of rice sent last year.
- Quilts and knit hats, and an "Everybody Birthday Party."
- Another ½ acre purchased across from Primary School.
- Secondary School (High School) 10 acre plot paid off in 13 months!
- Two producing wells on the Secondary School property.
- Uniforms purchased for 600 students!
- Final Primary School classroom building almost complete.
- Computer Lab almost complete
- Funding for computers through Sage Valley Jr. High School.
- Schooling to complete certification for two of our teaching staff.
- Sixth Grade Safari to see the animals they have never seen.
- Major surgery for one of our students, Joseph Nahum Kweka.
