The idea was to have coloring books that would encourage them in the Lord with pictures they could relate to and that would bring them joy. Then in September I injured my back and wasn't able to do the work so I felt the Lord lead me to have the children I teach do the work. From that point the Lord helped me every step of the way.



The major cost would be printing but a local newspaper gave us a very affordable cost. The community involved was really supportive and we raised the funds. In making contact with Gene and Lorraine, they encouraged the process and we felt the kinship of the family of God in His service. Even when we went to the post office to mail additional supplies there was prayer from the postal worker! In addition, a young woman from our church sent along hand made little blankets for beanie babies for the orphanage children. There are many more stories I could tell that made this project a labor of God's love. We are so excited to see pictures of the children receiving their coloring books and we believe The Lord will use them in ways only He can."
