"That's how come we have to give love every chance we get."

God is doing a mighty work and we feel so blessed to be involved. It's amazing to us that you have been so faithful to give of your resources, even above and beyond what we have asked. About 50 blankets were put on the containers in March to bless the students who are now housed in the first completed of four dormitory buildings. 
