"When Godwin and I arrived in Tanzania on Monday, April 1st, it was late in the evening. We were picked up at the airport at about 8PM, as usual, and then transported to the Village of Sakila where dinner was waiting for us before we retired for the evening. The next morning we got up, had breakfast, and went down to the Bible School for 8:00 a.m. coffee. The local men come to coffee for the purpose of discussing the current news and making plans for the day.

This particular morning we found out about a big surprise!! On Thursday we would be participating in the graduation ceremony of the Form 6 class! Form 6 is the last year of school before being appointed by the government to a University, provided test scores are high enough. This year's class would be the third group of students to graduate from our own Hebron High School. Our first class had 16 graduates and our second class had 21. All 37 have qualified due to their high-test scores to receive University appointments. From this year's class there would be 44 graduates, 27 boys and 17 girls. We are anxiously awaiting news on how these students did on their final exam. We hope we get another exceptional rate of qualified students.

Harrison Latiaeli Mungure (left in the photo) wants to be a doctor. Emmanuel Charles Urio (right) wants to be a park ranger. The girl in the center is Happy Hussein, a student from Christ Hope Orphanage. She has been a boarding student with us for 6 years now. She graduated last year with very high scores and has just received acceptance into the University College of Africa in Dar es Salaam where she will be studying tourism.

It's so exciting to see the effort these kids are putting into their education and to see that they can look forward to a future filled with hope. Godwin and I were so blessed and honored to be there and to take part in this ceremony. Thank you to all the sponsors who are giving these children a chance at a better life." ~Gene~
