2021 Food Drive

Godwin Selembo (School director) has said that our 1000 students will consume nearly 60 tons of corn, 16 tons of beans, and 26 tons of rice for the year. "The theme: we eat a lot!" "They don't know when the next meal will come, so they eat whenever they see a meal." ~Godwin Selembo~ We will be supporting the local economy around Sakila and Arusha for food purchases. We purchase our food in Tanzania to support their economy, and for cost effectiveness, as the numbers indicate below.

Arusha Region to Purchase

Corn-\$230 x 60 tons = \$13,800 Beans-\$390 x 16 tons = \$6,240 Rice-\$782 x 26 tons = \$20,332

United States to Purchase

Good quality grade corn- $$840 \times 60 \times $50,400 ($21 \text{ for } 50\text{lb bag})$ Beans- $$1000 \times 16 \times $16,000 ($25 \text{ for } 50\text{lb bag})$ Rice- $$960 \times 26 \times $24,960 ($24 \text{ for } 50\text{lb bag})$
